Nautilus Solar acquired development of a 132 kW system at the Gainesville Regional Airport. The power is being used under a Power Purchase Agreement by Gainesville Regional Utilities as part of its Feed-In-Tariff Program.

The roof mounted solar system is located on the roofs of two hangars operated by RD Air Services, LLC. For the use of its roof space, the company will receive a monthly lease payment, and will have no disruption to everyday operations.
