Project Overview

Nautilus Solar developed a 550 kW system for the Talbot County Community Center as part of the Sunburst Program from the Maryland Energy Administration. The 550kW ground mounted solar system is located on a field near Route 50 on County-owned property.

Nautilus Solar provided a PPA to the Talbot County Government at a fixed rate for 20 years. The Nautilus power rate is lower than the utility power rate and is projected to save the community over \$2,000,000 over the life of the agreement.
