



COMMUNITY SOLAR BILLING EXPLAINED

FOR MARYLAND SUBSCRIBERS WITH PEPCO

As a Maryland resident, you are on the dual bill option. Each month, you will receive a bill from your utility and a bill from Nautilus Solar Energy®.

Tips for Understanding Your Utility Statement & Solar Credits

- A PEPCO utility bill consists of delivery charges and supply charges.
- The delivery charges specify the cost of delivering energy through the electric grid to your home or business.
- The supply charges specify the cost of the energy you used during the bill period.
- Under 'Community Solar Bill Credit', you can see the solar energy deducted from utility bill at the rates specified by PEPCO.

Locating Solar Credits On Your Utility Bill

- You can locate your deduction of solar credits under the 'Community Solar Bill Credit' section. **664 kWhs (solar credits) are applied** at the utility's rates.
- Under 'Subscriber Organization', the name of your solar farm is listed. For example, the Beech Road solar farm is in Temple Hills, Maryland.
- At the top of the bill, solar credits are deducted from the total utility supply and delivery charges.
- In the example, **\$129.16 is** deducted from the utility bill and charged on the Nautilus Solar bill, **minus the 10% discount**.

Calculating the Outstanding PEPCO Balance

- $\$66.24 + 79.02 - \$129.16 = \$16.10$
- With dual billing, you still need to pay PEPCO delivery charges and any supply charges not covered by solar generation. This information can be located on the first page of your utility bill.

Community Solar Bill Credit: These credits reflect the kWh allocation you receive based on your subscription percentage and the solar facility's monthly generation.

Delivery Charges: These charges reflect the cost of bringing electricity to you. Current charges for 29 days, **winter rates in effect.**

UNDERSTANDING YOUR COMMUNITY SOLAR STATEMENT

Now that you understand how to locate solar credits on your PEPCO utility bill, we can now look at the Nautilus statement for your solar credits.

Remember, solar credits are not free. They are a way for residents and businesses to pay for a portion of their energy consumption at a discount while also producing clean, renewable energy.

BILL EXAMPLE

This customer's share of the solar farm generated 664 kWh (solar credits). At the standard rates provided by the utility, this calculates to \$129.16.

Solar Credit Cost:

- The cost of solar credits are calculated on the PEPCO utility bill using their rates.
- $(664 \text{ kWh} \times \$0.0604970) + (664 \text{ kWh} \times \$0.1340211) = \mathbf{\$129.16}$

Nautilus customers **save 10%** on the solar credits generated by the share of the solar farm, bringing the total down to **\$116.24** for a total **savings of \$12.92** on the monthly bill.

What Would Energy Cost Without Nautilus?

- Utility Charges: \$16.10
- + Initial Solar Credit Cost: \$129.16
- = Total Monthly Charges: **\$145.26** instead of **\$132.34**.

WHEN YOU'LL RECEIVE YOUR STATEMENTS

Your utility will likely send you a statement just a few days after your billing period ends. Your invoice for the same period from Nautilus Solar Energy may lag by 1-2 months. This delay reflects the time it takes to reconcile the solar credits transferred between your local utility company and Nautilus as part of the community solar program.
